MA in Comparative History / 1 YEAR / The program is built around the comparative research of early modern, modern and contemporary history. Students explore a broad range of topics and historical periods using different approaches to the past in global, regional, and local perspectives. Apart from offering intensive training and opportunities for specialization, the one-year MA is also envisioned as a program that helps students to prepare for entry into a doctoral program. → history.ceu.edu/content/programs

MA in Comparative History: From 1500 to Present / 2 YEARS / This program is for students who prefer a more flexible timeline for identifying and carrying out a research project or wish to delve into the study of research languages. Offering a systematic introduction to theories, methods and research skills, it helps students understand regional and global historical processes in a comparative perspective. → history.ceu.edu/content/programs

MA in History in the Public Sphere (HIPS) / 2 YEARS / This Erasmus Mundus master's program focuses on the ways the past is represented, contested and negotiated in the public sphere. It is operated by a consortium of universities in the EU and Japan and takes students to Vienna, Budapest, Tokyo, Florence, Lisbon and Paris. → hipsma.com

MA in European Women's and Gender History (MATILDA) / 2 YEARS / Offered jointly with the Department of Gender Studies, this program provides expertise in women's and gender history. It is operated by a consortium of universities, including the University of Vienna, the Université Lumière Lyon 2 and Università degli Studi di Padova. → history.ceu.edu/Matilda

PhD in Comparative History / The doctoral program offers a unique approach to the study of Central, Eastern and Southeastern Europe, as well as the Eastern Mediterranean and other historical regions, placing them in broader European and world history contexts. → history.ceu.edu/DoctoralPrograms
