The lecture will examine the phenomenon of ‘learned monasticism’ in Russia between 1880 and 1917, concentrating in particular on the career of Archbishop Antonii (Khrapovitskii) and his disciples, the so-called Antonievtsy, and exposing the potential for subversion on the Right by bishops who claimed to be the tsarist regime’s most loyal supporters.

Since 2008, **Simon Dixon** has been Sir Bernard Pares Professor of Russian History at UCL, having begun his career as a research fellow of Sidney Sussex College, Cambridge, and been Professor of Modern History at the University of Leeds.
